GENERAL RULES, TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. TDA rules apply to all MSPT tournaments.
2. Players and guests must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Players must have Casino's player card and valid ID to participate.
4. Registration for each Event will open two (2) hours prior to the scheduled start of play. Registration for the Main Event will open once certificates begin being issued.
5. The Tournament entry fee (the "Entry Fee") must be paid with cash or casino chips; no other forms of payment will be accepted.
6. All Events will use Tournament chips for play. Tournament chips have no cash value, may not be used for any other purpose, and must be returned to MSPT at the end of each Event.
7. All Events will utilize the Big Blind Ante format unless otherwise noted on the Tournament structure sheet. In the event that the player in the big blind has less than the required amount to post both the big blind and the ante, the ante will be posted first. The big blind will then be posted with any remaining Tournament chips.
8. Tournament chip stacks will be put into play at the start of the event for all registered players who have been issued a table and seat assignment. Players registered as an "alternate" will receive a seat assignment from the Tournament Staff when seating becomes available.
9. Alternates will be called in order. Alternates must be in the room when their number is called. If they are not in the room, TD will call the next number until an active player is available to take the seat. Alternates not in the room will be skipped and remain at the top of the alternate list. Once registration has closed, all alternates not present will have their chip stack put in play.
10. At the conclusion of the registration period, all paid entries (including alternates) who have yet to be seated will be assigned a seat and their Tournament chips will be put into play.
11. FireKeepers Casino does not permit refunds.
12. Players will need to refer to each Event's structure sheet for applicable details including but not limited to the scheduled dates of play, start times, and other relevant structure information.
13. IRS Compliance requires each player provide a valid government issued ID and a social security number. Nonresident aliens are subject to 30% US Income Tax withholding. ITIN's are required for Treaty Country exemptions. Tax form W-2G will be issued to all players winning in excess of \$5,000, net of the applicable Tournament Entry Fee.
14. Players must be clearly identifiable at all times. Tournament staff may request a player to remove any material (sunglasses, hood, or other facial cover) which inhibits their continuous identification or is a distraction to the other participants. Players are not allowed to wear sunglasses and a face cover at the same time.
15. Players who are unable to participate or are disqualified from an Event are not entitled to any refunds or payouts.
16. MSPT management reserves the right to revise, suspend, or cancel events at its sole discretion, without prior notice or liability.
17. Prior to the start of the Tournament, players may be required to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release as a condition of participating in the Tournament. If a player fails to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release, MSPT reserves the right to refuse entry to such individual.
18. Participants are prohibited from using gaming charts or any other poker training tool while in the Tournament area. Any participant found to be using gaming charts or any other poker training tool while in the Tournament area may be penalized in MSPT's sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.
19. Re-entries will be assigned a seat based on random draw or to balance tables at TD's discretion.
20. During hand for hand play the clock will continue to run. If there are 10 tables or less the clock will not run any longer than Three (3) minutes per hand. If there are more than 10 tables the clock will not run any longer than Four (4) minutes per hand.

Upon verification from Tournament Supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player will cease play, the total of his/her chips will be removed from play.

Prize Certificates: Players may play multiple Satellites and win multiple Prizes. Tournament Prize earned through this Satellite is Transferable.

Milestone Rules: A Player who accumulates 230,000 in tournament chips ("The Milestone") or more will instantly be awarded one (1) Tournament Prize. Upon verification from Tournament Supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player will cease play, the total of his/her chips will be removed from play.

- The Tournament will conclude when the number of players remaining is equal to the number of \$10,400 prizes generated based on the Tournament Prize Formula, less the amount of players who have previously won the prize by reaching the Milestone. Any Tournament prize pool residual funds, less than a \$10,400 prize, will be paid to the last player eliminated prior to the conclusion of the Tournament.
- While the tournament staff will make the best effort to identify players as they achieve the Milestone, it is the responsibility of each individual entrant to notify the Dealer or Tournament Supervisor when they have reached 230,000 in tournament chips.
- A player who is dealt into a subsequent hand after achieving the Milestone will be required to complete the hand prior to being awarded the Tournament Prize. If, at the completion of the additional hand, a players' chip total falls below the Milestone they are not eligible to receive the Tournament Prize until their chip total is once again equal to or greater than 230,000.
- A Tournament Supervisor must be called to verify the tournament chip count of a player who is making a claim for a Tournament Prize. Players may request that a Tournament Supervisor count their stack at any time between hands.
- A player who assists another in counting their chip stack or notifying them that they have reached the Milestone is not in breach of the rules.
- Any form of collusion, including the removal of tournament chips from the table, may result in penalty up to and including disqualification.
