Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- \$330 will go towards the prize pool. \$70 will go towards the administrative fee, which includes all staffing/dealer fees and rake.
